

## WILLIAM HARVEY II (abt. 1560- )

William Harvey II was born about 1560, the son of William of Bridgwater, Somersetshire, England. His father was an appointed King-of-Arms for King Edward VI and traveled in an official capacity to other countries of Europe. He retained this office for Queen Mary and until his death that occurred during the reign of Queen Elizabeth.

William, son of William, was residing in Bridgwater in 1630. Little is mentioned of William Jr. except that he had two sons, Henry and Thomas and that his grandfather was the famous warrior, Turner Harvey.<sup>1</sup> His son, Henry, purchased the ancient Castle of Bridgwater. The account is included in the story of Thomas (7-17). It is through Thomas that we link our immigrant ancestor to the earliest known Harvey in the line of Harvey progenitors.
