William Sayre of Hunwich, Parish of Podington, in the Hundred of Willey, Co. 1 Bradford, England, died 1564; his Will dated 1562, was proved 1564. The Will of his widow was dated 20 April, 1567 and proved June 2, 1567. Their children were:
